


Session 15 — The Tearing of the Seals 2-4 [Revelation 6:3-8] — May 16, 2021

- I. The rider on the <u>red horse</u> represents the supernatural <u>god</u> of <u>war</u> who will be given authority to take <u>peace</u> from the <u>earth</u> in the last days.
- II. The rider on the **black horse** represents devastating global **famines**, **economic collapse** and **hyper inflation** in the last days.
- III. The rider on the <u>pale horse</u> represents the <u>angel</u> of <u>death</u> or the <u>destroyer</u> who is given authority to take a <u>vast</u> <u>number</u> of human lives in the last days.
- IV. <u>Jesus</u> is the great Conquering King and Risen Savior who alone has <u>power</u> over death and Hades and the <u>authority</u> to give <u>eternal life</u> to all who <u>believe</u>!

- → Do not allow your love for Christ and other grow cold when lawlessness and violence abounds.
- Trust in Christ and in His resurrection life.
