Beast Kingdom





### SING TO THE LORD A NEW SONG; SING TO THE LORD, ALL THE EARTH. Psalm 96:1





As the end draws near, God's righteous anger will begin to **burn** hotter as He pours out the final 7 **plagues** upon the Beast and his kingdom.

"After this I looked, and the sanctuary of the tent of witness in heaven was opened, 6and out of the sanctuary came the seven angels with the seven plagues, clothed in pure, bright linen, with golden sashes around their chests."


[Revelation 15:5-6]

"And one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever, **8**and the sanctuary was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from his power, and no one could enter the sanctuary until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished."

Once God's anger has reached a boiling point, Jesus will **explode** on the scene in wrath and break out upon the ungodly as an <u>all</u> consuming fire.

"The LORD is a jealous and avenging God; the LORD is avenging and wrathful; the LORD takes vengeance on his adversaries and keeps wrath for his enemies."

[Nahum 1:2-3]

"The mountains quake before him; **the hills melt**; the earth heaves before him, the world and all who dwell in it.

<u>6</u>Who can stand before his indignation? Who can endure the heat of his anger? His wrath is poured out like fire, and the rocks are broken into pieces by him

"Therefore wait for Me," declares the LORD, "until the day I rise to testify. For My decision is to gather nations, to assemble kingdoms, to pour out upon them My indignation — all My burning anger. For all the earth will be consumed by the fire of My jealousy."


[2 Peter 3:7, 10]

"Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness, 12 waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn! 13But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells."


#### [2 Peter 3:11-13]

This phrase, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain. 28 Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, 29 for our God is a consuming fire." [Hebrews 12:27-29]





The song of **Moses** celebrates God's victory over **Pharaoh**, yet it ultimately points to God's **final** triumph when **Jesus** returns to destroy the Beast and save His people!



Then Moses and the people of Israel sang this song to the LORD, saying, "I will sing to the LORD, for he has triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider he has thrown into the sea. 2The LORD is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. 3The LORD is a man of war; the LORD is his name."

"Your right hand, O LORD, glorious in power, your right hand, O LORD, shatters the enemy. 7In the greatness of your majesty you overthrow your adversaries; you send out your fury; it consumes them like stubble."


