SACRIFICES in the MILLENNIUM

- 1. Provide atonement (covering) for mortals to come near to God.

"Come, I will show you the Bride, the wife of the Lamb."10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God, 11 having the glory of God, its radiance like a most rare jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal. It had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and on the gates the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were inscribed—" [Revelation 21:9-11]

"The one who conquers, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God.
