
# Old as Methuselah REASON #1 — Genealogies and ages are presented literally and historically in Scripture.


ENOCH was the <u>son</u> of <u>Jared</u> and the <u>father</u> of <u>Methuselah</u>. [Genesis

5:18-24]

#### ENOCH ...

- 1. Pleased God by <u>faith</u>. [Hebrews 11:5-6]\_
- 2. Walked in personal relationship with God
- 3. Was <u>taken</u> by the LORD and <u>translated</u> into heaven

Enoch was a *prophet* in his day, and his name literally means "teaching."



The **Book of Enoch – or 1 Enoch** 

 was not universally recognized as Scripture by either the Jewish or Christian communities of faith.

The **Book of Enoch**, however, was highly regarded by the Judeo-Christian community, dating all the way back to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Temple period, as confirmed by the Dead Sea Scrolls.

New Testament authors make reference to the *Book of Enoch*, even quoting it directly.

See 2 Peter 2:4-10 and Jude 1:6-7, 14-15

It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones, to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him."

# Old as Methuselah THE GOSPEL HIDDEN AND REVEALED IN THE GENAOLOGY OF GFNESIS 5

Adam ("Man")
Seth ("Appointed")
Enosh ("Mortal")
Kenan ("Sorrow")
Mahalalel ("The Blessed God")
Jared ("Shall come down")
Enoch ("Teaching")
Methuselah ("His death shall bring")
Lamech ("The despairing")
Noah ("Rest" or "Comfort")

If you put it all together, you get a sentence that reads something like this: "Man is appointed mortal sorrow, but the Blessed God shall come down teaching, and his death shall bring the despairing rest."

MAN IS APPOINTED MORTAL SORROW, BUT THE BLESSED GOD SHALL COME DOWN TEACHING. HIS DEATH SHALL BRING THE DESPAIRING REST.
